



- Msg on the timing monitors and through the RD radio channel
- Not before the race
- Also valid in case of Red flag (stop in front of your pit garage)

DRIVERS IN PIT LANE





One hand on the steering wheel at all times.

May unplug the radio or disconnect the drinks bottle and other such items,

Keep watching the road.

May loosen the belts - must remain in contact with the driver

Securely fastened before leaving the working area

Adjust the belts leaving the pit garage.

Art 20.1 – Minimum Pit Stop time





GT3

Short stop - fuel & max 1 tyre : Max 45 secs

Long stop - fuel & more than 1 tyre : Min 85 secs

No pit stops of a length from 45:00 - 84:99

NATIONAL GROUP

Short stop - fuel & max 1 tyre : Max 50 secs

Long stop - fuel & more than 1 tyre : Min 90 secs

No pit stops of a length from 50:00 - 89:99

One second tolerance 3 times during the race

Work on the cars after end of Qualifying Parc-Fermé

All cars at 45°

Extra set of tyres or one of the declared ones

If Stop = Parc-Fermé

If rejoined = all times cancelled < that moment

After chequered flag all cars in Parc Fermé in front of scrutineering garage

All cars to PF in the pit garages held for Max 1 hour, except for selected cars

USE OF WET TYRES





During practice sessions and Q: permitted when the track is declared "WET"

During the races: Free



NIGHT SIGNALLING





One front headlight not functioning	Repair at next pit stop
Both front headlights not functioning	Mechanical flag to stop
One rear light not functioning	Repair at next pit stop
Both rear lights not functioning	Mechanical flag to stop
One or both direction indicators not functioning	Repair at next pit stop
One stop light / brake light not functioning	Repair at next pit stop
Both stop light /brake lights not functioning	Mechanical flag to stop
Rain light not functioning in rain conditions	Mechanical flag to stop
Number illumination not working	Repair at next pit stop



































YELLOW LIGHTS ALL SESSIONS

















80 Km/Hr – NO Weaving (SC)

NO FCY during the three 1st laps - Safety Car

Countdown 20 seconds

- At 10 sec boards & lights No overtaking
- At 0 sec + yellow flags & all cars at 80 Km/Hr
- Restart on short notice 5,4,3,2,1 GREEN
- Green Flags at all posts

SC gets the leader during the FCY









- SC boards & YELLOW lights and flags
- Line up in one line behind SC
- Leader max 5 cars distance
- Other cars as tight as possible
- Green for restart at Control Line only in one line
- NO overtaking prior crossing the finish line



Pit exit remain **OPEN**

When the SC will pass the LINE, the pit exit will

be **CLOSED**

When the last car in the group behind SC passes the LINE, the pit exit will be

again **OPEN**



PROCEDURE





Slow down to 80 km/h – NO overtaking - enter the pit lane

Qualifying: The clock will stop

During the race: The clock will NOT stop

- Cars stops in front of the red line (at the line) in single file
- P-F condition (cleaning windows/lights, visual checking tires/ pressure/t°)
- Driver can go out of their car
- Restart behind SC
- Car entering the pit lane will lose a lap
