SPORTING NOTE #1 - 10/12/2020 DRIVER FACING CAMERA

As all cars are equipped with a Driver Facing Camera, for safety reasons the following article is added to the Sporting Regulations and clarification added to article 33.13:

19.7 Onboard Driver-facing Safety Cameras

For safety reasons, Competitors must install an additional onboard Camera integrated with the data acquisition system which must be installed in the car as specified in the installation manual (see Appendix 7) throughout the Competition, and which will be facing towards the driver, so that the seat belts can be clearly seen.

It is the responsibility of each Competitor to obtain the Onboard Safety Camera system and to install it in strict compliance with the relevant instructions. The weight of the Onboard Safety Camera system is included in the minimum weight of the car.

The camera must be switched on whenever the car is moving. Any infractions may be reported to the Stewards.

33.13 - paragraph 2

Any infractions noted by the pit lane marshals or the driver-facing safety camera may be reported to the Stewards.
