The Stewards, having received a request from the competitor and having heard from the competitor's representative, have considered the following matter and determine the following:

Competitor: AF Corse


Fact: The drivers will not be able to attend the scheduled drivers' briefing and sporting checks or participate in the night familiarisation practice session.

Offence: Breach of Articles 14.2, 15.6 and 16.2 of the 11th Gulf 12 Hours Race 2022 Sporting & Technical Regulations


Decision: **There will be no penalty in this case but the competitor must ensure that:**
(i) the drivers complete sporting checks and receive a personal briefing from the Race Director before participating in any on-track session; and
(ii) the drivers participate in the evening Team Track Walk scheduled for Saturday 10th December to provide familiarisation with the track lighting.

Reason: The drivers are subject to a mandatory requirement to participate in the FIA Award Ceremony on Bologna which means they are unable to arrive at this event until the Qualifying session. The Stewards note the relevant requirements and the significant penalties for breach which are set out within the FIA WEC regulations, as well as the experience of both professional drivers. Accordingly, they accept this as being a case of force majeure and determine that no penalty is appropriate in this instance.

Competitors are reminded that they have the right to appeal certain decisions of the Stewards, in accordance with Article 15 of the FIA International Sporting Code, within the applicable time limits.
