


The Stewards, having received a request from the competitor and having heard from the competitor's representative, have considered the following matter and determine the following:

**No. / Driver:** 44 / Klaus Bachler  
**Competitor:** Herberth Motorsport  
**Fact:** The drivers will not be able to attend the scheduled drivers' briefing and sporting checks and will be unable to participate in the night familiarisation practice session.  
**Offence:** Breach of Articles 14.2, 15.6 and 16.2 of the 11<sup>th</sup> Gulf 12 Hours Race 2022 Sporting & Technical Regulations  
**Decision:** **There will be no penalty in this case but the competitor must ensure that:**  
**(i) the driver completes sporting checks and receives a personal briefing from the Race Director before participating in any on-track session; and**  
**(ii) the driver participates in the evening Team Track Walk scheduled for Saturday 10<sup>th</sup> December to provide familiarisation with the track lighting.**  
**Reason:** The driver has a contractual responsibility which means he is unable to arrive on time at this event. The Stewards note the circumstances as well as the experience of the driver, including experience of this circuit. Accordingly, they accept this as being a case of force majeure and determine that no penalty is appropriate in this instance.

Competitors are reminded that they have the right to appeal certain decisions of the Stewards, in accordance with Article 15 of the FIA International Sporting Code, within the applicable time limits.
