Competitor: 2 Seas Motorsport


Fact: The engine of car 51 has been changed after Test Practice 3

Offence: Breach of Article T2 of the 11th Gulf 12 Hours Race 2022 Sporting & Technical Regulations

Decision: **No further action**

Reason: The engine of car 51 has been changed due to a technical issue during Test Practice 3. Having heard from the competitor's representative, this is acknowledged as being a breach of the above regulation but as this took place before the start of Free Practice and Qualifying, the Stewards determine that no penalty is appropriate in this instance.

Competitors are reminded that they have the right to appeal certain decisions of the Stewards, in accordance with Article 15 of the FIA International Sporting Code, within the applicable time limits.
