The Stewards, having received a request from the competitor and having heard from the competitor's representative, have considered the following matter and determine the following:

**No. / Driver:** 51 / Lewis Williamson – Aaron Walker – James Cottingham

**Competitor:** 2 Seas Motorsport


**Fact:** The drivers were unable to participate in the night familiarisation practice session.

**Offence:** Breach of Article 16.2 of the 11<sup>th</sup> Gulf 12 Hours Race 2022 Sporting & Technical Regulations

**Decision:** **There will be no penalty in this case but the competitor must ensure that the drivers participate in the evening Team Track Walk scheduled for Saturday 10<sup>th</sup> December to provide familiarisation with the track lighting.**

**Reason:** Car 51 suffered a technical issue which prevented participation in the night familiarisation session. The Stewards, noting the circumstances as well as the experience of the drivers, accept this as being a case of force majeure and determine that no penalty is appropriate in this instance.

Competitors are reminded that they have the right to appeal certain decisions of the Stewards, in accordance with Article 15 of the FIA International Sporting Code, within the applicable time limits.
