























PITS AND **PROCEDURES**



















No car on the fast lane BEFORE the message « FAST LANE OPEN » on monitor and radio















ART 20.1 PIT STOP TIMES





Fuel & tyre change at the same time:

- Any GT3 Pit Stop including refuelling: minimum period of 68.000 secs
- The pit stop times may be adjusted during the Event and any changes will be published by the Stewards in a Bulletin.
- Any GT4 Pit Stop including refuelling: minimum period of 83.000 secs
- No minimum if no refuelling

A one-second tolerance is permitted refuelling stops - 3 times maximum during the race.













PARC FERME





- After Pre Qualifying all cars will be under parc ferme conditions in their garages.
- After Q3, all cars will be under parc ferme conditions in their garages except cars selected near the scrutineering box.

• After the Race, all cars will be under parc ferme conditions in their garages except selected cars in front of the scrutineering box







Yellow flags will be shown around the circuit

Pole man to control the pace
Information will be given on the team radio







Kyalami SuperCup Starting grid START BACK OF THE GRID IN THE ORDER OF THE QUALIFY

End of the 1 hour race:
The national flag will be shown on the line
Don't slow down and enter the pits















FLAGS AND LIGHTS

















FULL COURSE YELLOW





- Countdown from 20 seconds "Full Course Yellow in 20 seconds"
- At 10 seconds, the FCY boards will be displayed No overtaking
- At 0 seconds the yellow flags and yellow lights will be displayed, all cars at 80 kph
- Option A "Restart on short notice" Green Flags at all posts
- Option B Safety Car to pick up the leader



• No Full Course Yellow for the first three laps of the race











SAFETY CAR





- Safety Car boards & Yellow Lights and Flags
- All cars to be a maximum of 5 car lengths from the car in front
- Safety Car lights off at Int 2 (before turn 12)
- Green for restart at Control Line only
- No overtaking prior crossing the control line




















RED FLAG







Slow down to 80 kph – no overtaking

Practice - return to the pit lane

- the clock will NOT stop

Qualifying - return to the pit lane

- the clock WILL stop

Race

- stop on the track at the red line (in single file)
- the clock will NOT stop
- Parc Ferme condition, drivers may get out of the cars
- restart behind the safety car
