

The Stewards notify all competitors and officials of the following:


Fuel handling in Pit Area

- Fuel to be handed out from the bulk fuel storage area by Fast Race Fuels. Each unopened fuel container will have a sticker on "Fuel drum full"
- Only Fast Race Fuels representatives will work in the bulk fuel store and distribute the fuel
- Each Kyalami 9hour car will start with 200L (one container at the start of the race).
- One 200L fuel drum will be emptied into the fuel rig for refuelling.
- Any un-sealed fuel drum will be stored in the safe passage behind each pit garage against the wall under the correct allocated sign.
- When you have an empty fuel drum it must be taken back to the bulk fuel storage for an exchange for a fully sealed drum which will then be stored in the safe passage behind each pit garage against the wall under the correct allocated sign.
- Each Kyalami 9hour car will get space at the back of their garage against the wall with a sign where they must store their fuel drums. No fuel drums are allowed to be stored in the garage or working area.
- Visible stickers will be presented against the wall for the correct storage of the fuel drums. There will be three visible indication for the following drums;
 - Full drums (200 L and new sealed drums)
 - Half full drums (any opened and used drums)
 - Empty drums must be taken back to the bulk fuel storage area as soon as possible
- You can only get a new sealed fuel drum when you bring back your empty fuel drum
- Each Kyalami 9hour car is allowed to have a clean empty drum (we are going refer to this as the 'emergency drum') close to the fuel rig for any overflow when they finish refuelling the car.
- 4 Fire wardens will be appointed and will follow the following procedure:
 - Dedicated fire wardens will be responsible to make sure each team stores all their fuel drums in the safe passage behind each pit garage against the wall as indicated
 - Fire wardens will continuously monitor and ensure that the correct drums are standing in the designated places
 - Fire wardens will make sure no fuel drum is leaking and that it is stored safely against the wall
 - Fire wardens to report back to Jaco if teams do not comply or if any fuel drums are leaking.
 - If a fuel drum is leaking there is a spill kit with absorbent to contain the leak and a fire team to assist


- The fire Wardens will make sure the team use the half drum of fuel and when empty put a sticker on it " Fuel drum empty" and the team can then return it to the bulk fuel storage area
- Each fire warden will go through training and a walk through on this procedure and sign that they understand this procedure
- When refuelling it is compulsory for a supervisor to be present and equipped with an fire extinguisher and located 2 meters from the refuelling point
- Fire-resistant clothing to be worn by persons located within 2 meters
- Ensure stability and earthing of refuelling towers
- Compulsory presence of absorptive substance in the stand - never water
- Compulsory presence of 2 extinguishers (9 kg powder or 9l foam) in each stand
- Fuel will only be issued against a Voucher received from Fast Race Fuels once Empty Drums have been delivered to the Bulk storage Yard = No Empty = No Fuel Issue
- Fast Race Fuels will issue these vouchers on receipt of the empty drum against previously full issued drum.
- Hand pumps, pneumatic pumps or explosion-proof electrical pumps. NO batteries
- Compulsory presence of a supervisor equipped with an extinguisher and located 2 meters from the refueling point
- Fire-resistant clothing to be worn by persons located within 2 meters
- Ensure stability and EARTH AND BONDING of refueling towers
- Compulsory presence of absorptive substance in the stand - never water
- Compulsory presence of 2 extinguishers (9 kg powder) in each stand
