Fact:

Intermittent GPS and non-functioning driver ID system.

Offence:

Breach of Articles 19.3, 19.5 & 27.7 of the 2023 Kyalami 9 Hour Sporting Regulations

Decision:

The competitor must ensure that the GPS system is working correctly and that the

organisers are informed which driver is in the car at all times.

Reason:

The Competitors representative explained that they have re-positioned the GPS aerial and have confirmed with the Chief Timekeeper that the GPS system is now working correctly. However they are still experiencing issues with the Driver ID system which cannot be rectified. The Stewards accept that for this event only the competitor must inform the organisers manually by means of pit reports the time that each driver enters

and exits the car.

Competitors are reminded that they have the right to appeal certain decisions of the Stewards, in accordance with Article 15 of the FIA International Sporting Code, within the applicable time limits.
