TEAM MANAGERS' AND DRIVERS' BRIEFING NOTES

To be read in conjunction with the PowerPoint presentations shown in the briefings and published on the Digital Notice Board.

THE CIRCUIT

- The control [Times] Line is 110 metres before the Start Line.

 The pit lane speed limit is 60 µm.

 When extend the past divides must keep to the light of the line at all times. Any part of a tyle of any car entering the pit may not closs the white line.

 The effect forming line is 5 metres before the Country Line.

 The distance from the Art in timing line is to the Pot Out timing line is 355 4 metres.

During the race, the procedure for any track limit breaches will be:

- ▶ 1st offence noted.
- 2nd offence warning over the team radio, where possible.
- $\gg 3^{\rm rd}$ offence the car will be shown the black/white warning flag, a message will be placed on the timing screen and a message will be sent over the team radio, where possible
- 4th offence report to the Stewards who may impose a penalty.
- Once a team manager has been summoned to the Stewards the counter will normally reset to zero
- > The Stewards may impose more severe penalties for cars that repeatedly breach the track limits.

- Countdown from 20 seconds "Full Course Yellow in 20 seconds"
- At 10 seconds, the FCY light panels will be illuminated NO OVERTAKING
- Countdown over the Team Radio "5, 4, 3,"
- At 0 seconds the FCY light panels will start flashing, all cars must be at 80 kph
- Option A "Restart on short notice" Green Flags at all posts
- Option B Safety Car to pick up the leader
- No Full Course Yellow for the first three laps of the race

Slow down to 80 kph – no overtaking







If the Safety Car is deployed during the race, all drivers should beware that this is where the Safety

SAFETY CAR



- Safety Car boards & Yellow Lights and Flags

All cars to be a maximum of 5 car lengths from the car in front

- Safety Car lights out at Int 2 (turn 9)
- Green for restart at all points
- No overtaking or overlapping prior to crossing the control line
