The Stewards, having received a report from the Race Director, having examined video evidence, summoned and heard from the drivers and the competitors' representatives, have considered the following matter and determine the following:

**No. / Driver:** 3 / Ian Loggie  
**Competitor:** 2 Seas Motorsport  
**Time (fact):** 15:17 hrs  
**Session:** Free Practice 2  
**Fact:** Cars 3 and 4 collided at turn 5  
**Offence:** Breach of Article 8.6 of the 12<sup>th</sup> Gulf 12 Hours Race 2023 Sporting & Technical Regulations and Chapter IV Article 2d) of Appendix L to the FIA International Sporting Code  
**Decision:** **Reprimand**  
**Reason:** Car 3 collided with the rear of car 4 at turn 5, causing car 3 to spin. Both cars continued. Having heard from both drivers and competitors' representatives and having viewed CCTV footage the Stewards consider that driver 3 was predominantly responsible for causing the collision through a minor misjudgement. Noting that the contact was minor, that both cars continued and no competitive advantage was gained they impose a Reprimand in this instance.

Competitors are reminded that they have the right to appeal certain decisions of the Stewards, in accordance with Article 15 of the FIA International Sporting Code, within the applicable time limits.
