<b>Category</b>	Bathurst 12hr
<b>Car and Driver</b>	Car 24 Jake Santalucia Anthony Levitt Cameron Campbell
<b>Competitor</b>	Car 24 Method Motorsport
<b>Date</b>	Sunday, 02 February 2025
<b>Session</b>	Race
<b>Fact</b>	Jake Santalucis of Car 24 exceeded the permitted maximum continuous driver time by 9 minutes
<b>Rule</b>	Sporting & Technical Regulations Article 4.7.4.3 – Mandatory Driving Times, If a Driver exceeds the maximum continuous and/or maximum cumulative Driving time requirement by more than 5 minutes, the following penalties will apply: + 30 seconds for every minute in-excess of 5 minutes.
<b>Decision</b>	Two minute and 30 second Time Penalty added to Race time.
<b>Reason</b>	Driver Jake Santalucis continuous driving time from 0927hrs to 1136hrs (129 mins) exceeded the maximum continuous driving time of 120 minutes for an unclassified driver.

The Competitor/Driver is reminded that decisions and penalties that may be subject to appeal are set out in the Circuit Race Standing Regulations, Article 7, and the right to and process for appeal are set out in the National Competition Rules, Article 101 and Articles 105 - 106.
